This fishery is now entering the 'information gathering' stage of the re-assessment against the MSC *Principles and Criteria for Sustainable Fishing*. A key purpose of this stage is to collect information on the fishery and in particular to speak to representatives of the fishery, fishery management and environmental management bodies. We expect to carry out most meetings over the period **4-8 May 2009** at **Seattle, WA**.

We would, at the same time, also collect information for the fourth surveillance audit report under the fishery's current certification.
