Certification - Extension of Scope

A memorandum of agreement (MOA) has been signed by the At-Sea Processors Association (APA) and the Best Use Coalition (BUC) and the Alaska Fisheries Development Foundation (AFDF) so that the incidental harvest of MSC certified species taken in their respective fisheries can be marketed as eligible to carry the MSC logo subject to MSC chain of custody requirements. The eligibility dates for when this applies corresponds to the date when the MOAs were signed.

The following table sets out which incidental species can be marketed by which fishery from what date.

The assessment teams for each fishery have confirmed that this will not compromise any of the certifications and this variation to the normal MSC requirements in this exceptional circumstance has been agreed by the MSC Technical Advisory Board.
