#### **Confirmed Peer Reviewers (in alphabetical order):**

##### ***Dr Art DeVries***

Dr DeVries is Professor of Animal Biology and Physiology at the University of Illinois, USA. His research centres on the biology of cold-water fishes and he provides to the review expertise on variation in populations of toothfish and is able to apply data on the biology of toothfish stocks in general to particular issues regarding the targeted populations in SGSSI.

##### ***Dr Euan Dunn***

Dr Dunn is Senior Marine Policy Officer at the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (the UK partner of BirdLife International) where his responsibilities include policy development and advocacy on all issues affecting interactions between fisheries and marine birds, nationally and internationally. He brings to the review expertise on ecosystem effects of fisheries, particularly interactions with seabirds.

##### ***Dr Edith Fanta***

Dr Fanta is Associate Professor at the Federal University of Parana, Brazil. Her research activities include organisation of a laboratory on fish biology and a group for studies on environmental impacts on fish. Dr Fanta has been involved with the Brazilian Antarctic Program since 1983 and is Brazilian representative at the Scientific Committee and at the Commission for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources (CCAMLR) and was vice-Chair of the Scientific Committee of CCAMLR (1999-2001), and member of the Editorial Board of CCAMLR Science. Dr Fanta has also organised a Scientific Observer course for Antarctic long line and trawl fisheries, and lectured on CCAMLR conservation measures, and the ecosystem approach.

##### ***Dr Kevin Stokes***

Dr Stokes is Chief Scientist with the New Zealand Seafood Industry Council (SeaFIC) Ltd. He has wide fishery assessment, management and review experience including familiarity with the MSC assessment process. Dr Stokes provides to the review extensive knowledge of fishery management but is totally independent of the management regime for the fishery under assessment.
