


CHRISTMAS PRAWNAMENT

- Sticky tape or glue





Make two small cuts to form a triangle 13.

Flip paper and cut carefully most of the way up the shorter side to form two strips 15.




Re-fold the top corners inwards













Press along the back edge, then open









Cut a very small hole in the back of the 13. prawn to thread string through



Tie your piece of string into a loop 14.







Thread string through hole in back of prawn with the knot on the inside 16.



You may want to seal the string and two 17. edges of the prawn together with tape or glue


