Code of Good Practice for Technical Consultants

Individuals and organisations listed as Technical Consultants have signed up to the following Code of Good Practice

- 1. Support the concept of sustainable fishing practices as elaborated in the MSC's Fisheries Standard.
- 2. Ensure dealings are consistent with the highest professional standards at all times.
- 3. Respect the confidentiality and privacy of clients.
- 4. Be truthful and accurate. Maintain ethical practices in the provision of services and adhere to recognised standards of fairness and personal integrity.
- 5. Provide full and true disclosure of any interests, financial or otherwise, which if not disclosed to the client may raise a conflict of interest.
- 6. Do not carry out assignments which may be beyond the expertise and skills of the consultant.
- 7. Ensure that advisory and consultancy services are separated from auditing services and that conflicting situations involving provision of both these services to the same client are clearly avoided.
- 8. Ensure that there is a mutual understanding between the client and the consultant on objectives, scope of work and deliverables of the project.
- 9. Ensure activities are implemented in a timely manner in accordance with work plans agreed with clients.
- 10. Comply with all regulatory and statutory requirements which may be applicable to the conduct of the consultants' activities and which are applicable in the jurisdiction of the client and/or the physical location of the work being undertaken.
- 11. Where appropriate, use tools that ensure the development of credible FIPs.
