








Welcome to the second edition of our MSC quarterly update delivering all the key news, market trends and latest data on sustainable tuna direct to your inbox.

In 2021/22 the total global MSC certified sustainable tuna catch reached a record of nearly 2 million tonnes, comparto less than 1 million tonnes in 2017/18.





## SUPPLY: SUSTAINABILITY OF GLOBAL TUNA CATCH



**AGAC** – assessment of all catch in 4 Oceans. 3% of global tuna catches.

**ANABAC**- in assessment for SKJ in the IO (23k t)

Improvements: use of non entangling and biodegradable FADS. Scientific research to monitor the impact of derelict FADs on corals and vulnerable ecosystems.



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
# GROWING DEMAND OF MSC TUNA GLOBALLY (T)






# VOLUME MSC LABEL BY TUNA SPECIES (GLOBAL)







22/23 figures, 1st Semester only.


In 21/22






#### TOP COUNTRIES BY TUNA PRODUCTS LIVE



#### Live products by distribution country




